*LightSwitch: Video Installations on the Jesse H. Jones Communication Complex - May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2005 at the University of Texas at Austin*

(Austin, Texas) - A semester-long investigation of the projection and reception of moving images proposed by Radio-TV-Film faculty member Samantha Krukowski will culminate in **LightSwitch** on Saturday, May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2005 from Sunset to Midnight.

Students from across disciplines at the University of Texas at Austin will be using the three buildings, plaza and surrounds of the Jesse H. Jones Communication Center as sites for the projection and viewing of large scale video installations.

The College of Communication complex at the University of Texas at Austin has long been a monolithic landmark occupying the corner of 26<sup>th</sup> Street and Guadalupe. The three buildings house numerous operations and academic departments, including The Daily Texan, The Austin City Limits studio, KUT Radio, KVR-TV, as well as the Advertising, Communication Sciences and Disorders, Communication Studies, Journalism and Radio-TV-Film Departments.
